| PRODUCTION PROCEDURES | The antibody to bovine IgG was isolated by affinity chromatography using antigen coupled to agarose beads and conjugated to biotin. |

Immunoglobulin concentration was determined using Beer's Law where 1 mg/mL IgG has an A280 of 1.4.

By immunoelectrophoresis and ELISA this antibody reacts specifically with bovine IgG and with light chains common to other bovine immunoglobulins. No antibody was detected against non-immunoglobulin serum proteins. This antibody may cross react with IgG from other species.

APPLICATIONS Centrifuge tube to remove product from lid. Optimal working dilutions should be determined experimentally by the investigator. Prepare working dilution immediately before use.
