PRODUCTION PROCEDURES

Antiserum was cross adsorbed using bovine, chicken, goat, human, mouse, pig and rat immunosorbents to remove cross reactive antibodies. The antibody to rabbit IgG was isolated by affinity chromatography using antigen coupled to agarose beads and conjugated

to biotin.

Immunoglobulin concentration was determined using Beer's Law where $1\,mg/mL$ IgG has an

A280 of 1.4. Biotin/antibody protein ratio is 4:1.

By immunoelectrophoresis and ELISA this antibody reacts specifically with rabbit IgG and with light chains common to other rabbit immunoglobulins. No antibody was detected against non-immunoglobulin serum proteins. Less than 1% cross reactivity to bovine, chicken, goat, human, mouse, pig and rat IgG was detected. This antibody may cross react

with IgG from other species.

Biotinylated antibody was demonstrated by reaction with avidin/peroxidase when coated on

microtiter wells. Working dilutions should be determined by the investigator.

APPLICATIONS Centrifuge tube to remove product from lid. Optimal working dilutions should be determined

experimentally by the investigator. Prepare working dilution immediately before use.
