PRODUCTION PROCEDURES

Antibody was affinity purified using an epitope specific to MIRK immobilized on solid support.

The epitope recognized by A302-483A maps to a region between residue 500 and 550 of human minibrain-related kinase using the numbering given in entry NP\_004705.1 (GeneID 9149).

Antibody concentration was determined by extinction coefficient: absorbance at 280 nm of 1.4

equals 1.0 mg of IgG.

**APPLICATIONS** Centrifuge tube to remove product from lid. Optimal working dilutions should be determined

experimentally by the investigator. Prepare working dilution immediately before use.



Detection of human MIRK by western blot and immunoprecipitation. Samples: Whole cell lysate (5, 15 and 50  $\mu$ g for WB; 1 mg for IP, 20% of IP loaded) from HeLa cells. Antibodies: Affinity purified rabbit anti–MIRK antibody A302–483A used for WB at 0.1  $\mu$ g/ml (A) and 1  $\mu$ g/ml (B) and used for IP at 10  $\mu$ g/mg lysate. MIRK was also immunoprecipitated by rabbit anti–MIRK antibody BL8547, which recognizes a downstream epitope. Detection: Chemiluminescence with exposure times of 1 minute (A) and 30 seconds (B).
