PRODUCTION PROCEDURES

Antibody was affinity purified using an epitope specific to Bin1 immobilized on solid support.

The epitope recognized by A302-729A maps to a region between residue 543 and 593 of human Bridging Integrator 1 using the numbering given in entry NP_647593.1 (GenelD 274).

Antibody concentration was determined by extinction coefficient: absorbance at 280 nm of 1.4

equals 1.0 mg of IgG.

APPLICATIONS Centrifuge tube to remove product from lid. Optimal working dilutions should be determined

experimentally by the investigator. Prepare working dilution immediately before use.







Detection of human Bin1 by western blot. Samples: Whole cell lysate (50 μ g) from HeLa, HEK293T, and Jurkat cells. Antibodies: Affinity purified rabbit anti-Bin1 antibody A302-729A (lot A302-729A-2) used for WB at 1 μ g/ml. Detection: Chemiluminescence with an exposure time of 3 minutes.

Detection of human Bin1 by western blot of immunoprecipitates. Samples: Whole cell lysate (0.5 or 1.0 mg per IP reaction; 20% of IP loaded) from HeLa cells. Antibodies: Affinity purified rabbit anti-Bin1 antibody A302-729A (lot A302-729A-2) used for IP at 6 μg per reaction. Bin1 was also immunoprecipitated by rabbit anti-Bin1 antibody A302-728A. For blotting immunoprecipitated Bin1, A302-729A was used at 1 μg/ml. Detection: Chemiluminescence with an exposure time of 3 minutes.



Detection of human Bin1 by immunohistochemistry. Sample: FFPE section of human ovarian carcinoma. Antibody: Affinity purified rabbit anti-Bin1 (Cat. No. A302-729A Lot2) used at a dilution of 1:1,000 (1µg/ml) Detection: DAB
