Antibody was affinity purified using an epitope specific to TIF-IA immobilized on solid support.

The epitope recognized by A303-065A maps to a region between residue 601 and 651 of human Transcription Initiation Factor IA using the numbering given in entry NP_060897.3 (GeneID

54700).

Antibody concentration was determined by extinction coefficient: absorbance at 280 nm of 1.4

equals 1.0 mg of IgG.



Antibodies: Affinity purified rabbit anti-TIF-IA antibody A303-065A used for WB at 0.1 μ g/ml (A) and 1 μ g/ml (B) and used for IP at 6 μ g/mg lysate. TIF-IA was also immunoprecipitated by rabbit anti-TIF-IA antibody BL11066, which recognizes an upstream epitope. Detection: Chemiluminescence with exposure times of 3 minutes (A) and 10 seconds (B).
