<b>PRODUCTION PROCEDURES</b>	Antibody was affinity purified using an epitope specific to Beta-2-adaptin immobilized on solid support.

The epitope recognized by A304-719A maps to a region between residue 575 to 625 of human Beta-2-adaptin using the numbering given in entry NP\_001273.1 (GeneID 163).

Antibody concentration was determined by extinction coefficient: absorbance at 280 nm of 1.4 equals 1.0 mg of IgG.

**APPLICATIONS** Centrifuge tube to remove product from lid. Optimal working dilutions should be determined experimentally by the investigator. Prepare working dilution immediately before use.

Western Blot 1:2,000 – 1:10,000

Immunoprecipitation 2 – 10 µg/mg lysate

**APPLICATION NOTES** Western blot of immunoprecipitates performed using Normal Pig Serum (Cat. No. S100-020), Goat anti-Rabbit Light Chain HRP Conjugate (Cat. No. A120-113P) and 4-8% SDS-PAGE (link to IP-western blot protocol in Additional Info section below).

Western blot of lysates performed using standard western blot reagents and 4-8% SDS-PAGE.

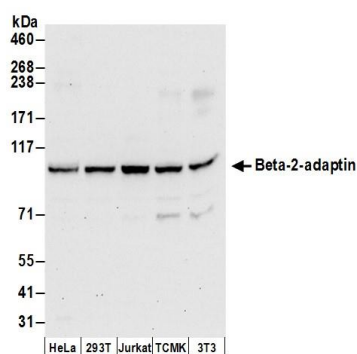

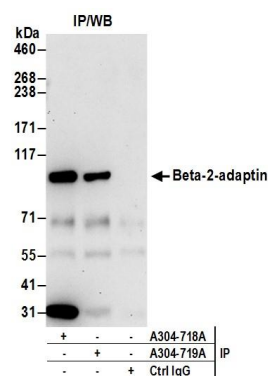

**Detection of human and mouse Beta-2-adaptin by western blot.** *Samples:* Whole cell lysate (50 µg) from HeLa, HEK293T, Jurkat, mouse TCMK-1, and mouse NIH 3T3 cells prepared using NETN lysis buffer. *Antibodies:* Affinity purified rabbit anti-Beta-2-adaptin antibody A304-719A (lot A304-719A-1) used for WB at 0.1 µg/ml. *Detection:* Chemiluminescence with an exposure time of 30 seconds.



**Detection of human Beta-2-adaptin by western blot of immunoprecipitates.** *Samples:* Whole cell lysate (0.5 or 1.0 mg per IP reaction; 20% of IP loaded) from 293T cells prepared using NETN lysis buffer. *Antibodies:* Affinity purified rabbit anti-Beta-2-adaptin antibody A304-719A (lot A304-719A-1) used for IP at 6 µg per reaction. Beta-2-adaptin was also immunoprecipitated by rabbit anti-Beta-2-adaptin antibody A304-718A. For blotting immunoprecipitated Beta-2-adaptin, A304-719A was used at 1 µg/ml. *Detection:* Chemiluminescence with an exposure time of 10 seconds.
