PRODUCTION PROCEDURES

Antibody was affinity purified using an epitope specific to TAL1 immobilized on solid support.

The epitope recognized by A305-300A maps to a region between residue 1 to 50 of human T-cell acute lymphocytic leukemia protein 1 using the numbering given in entry P17542.2 (GeneID

6886).

Antibody concentration was determined by extinction coefficient: absorbance at 280 nm of 1.4

equals 1.0 mg of IgG.





Detection of human TAL1 by western blot. Samples: Whole cell lysate (50 μ g) from HeLa, HEK293T, and Jurkat cells prepared using NETN lysis buffer. Antibody: Affinity purified rabbit anti-TAL1 antibody A305-300A (lot A305-300A-1) used for WB at 0.1 μ g/ml. Detection: Chemiluminescence with an exposure time of 30 seconds.

Detection of human TAL1 by western blot of immunoprecipitates. Samples: Whole cell lysate (0.5 or 1.0 mg per IP reaction; 20% of IP loaded) from Jurkat cells prepared using NETN lysis buffer. Antibodies: Affinity purified rabbit anti-TAL1 antibody A305-300A (lot A305-300A-1) used for IP at 6 μg per reaction. TAL1 was also immunoprecipitated by rabbit anti-TAL1 antibody BL21033. For blotting immunoprecipitated TAL1, A305-300A was used at 0.4 μg/ml. Detection: Chemiluminescence with an exposure time of 30 seconds.
